Pretty URLs is a PrestaShop Friendly URL module that removes auto generated ID from the URLs of product, categories, suppliers, manufacturers and CMS pages. Clean links are search friendly and an essential requirement for SEO. This module provides a report on duplicate and conflicting URLs for products and categories if there are, so that you can troubleshoot and correct easily.

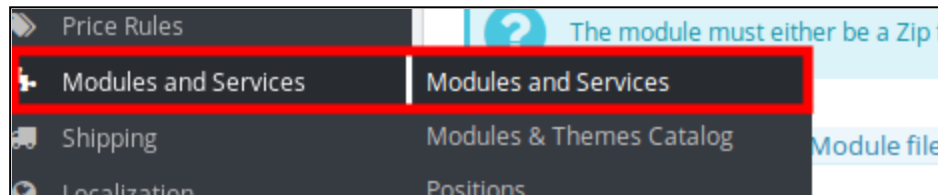

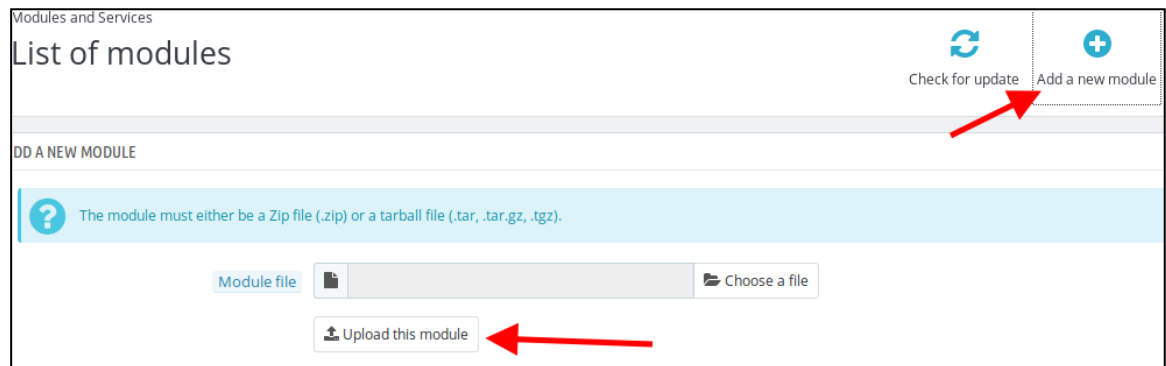
Installation Instructions

Compatible - PrestaShop 1.5 – 1.6.x

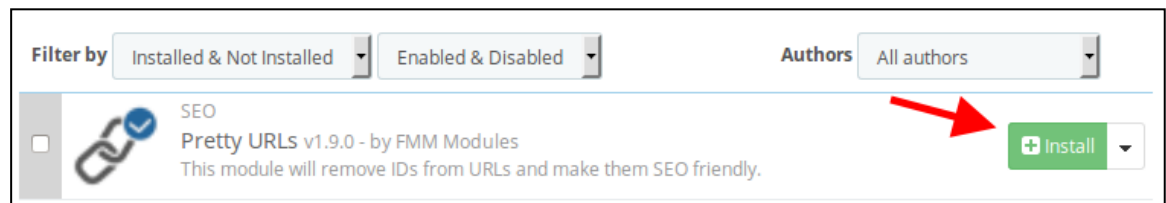
1. Go to Back office and from Menu go to **Modules** → **Modules**



2. Click **Add a new module** → Browse for Downloaded Module ZIP file and click **Upload this module**.



3. After module is uploaded just click **Install** button and you are done.



4. Make sure you do clear **Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance** after module installation.
5. Please make sure Friendly URL is turned on in **Preferences** → **SEO & URLs**.

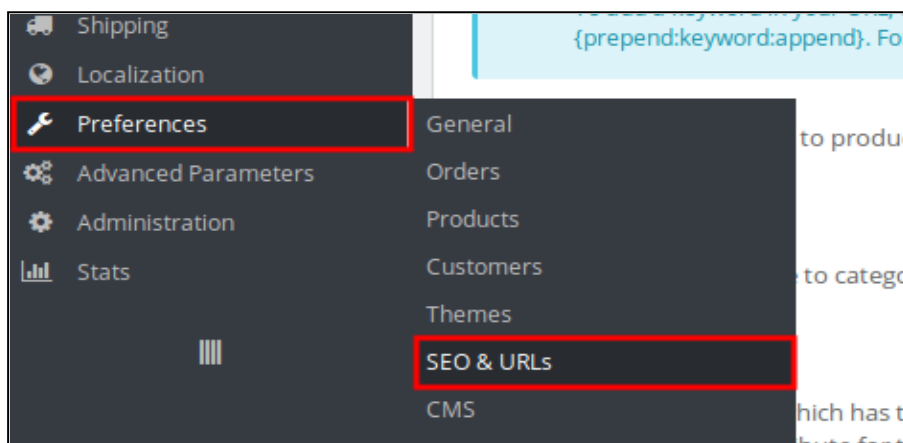


URL Settings

Once this module is installed, all the URLs on your store will be automatically updated i-e., IDs will be removed. There is nothing that you need to do.

Additional Settings:

For changing URLs to your needs go to **Preferences – SEO & URLs**



URL Structure:

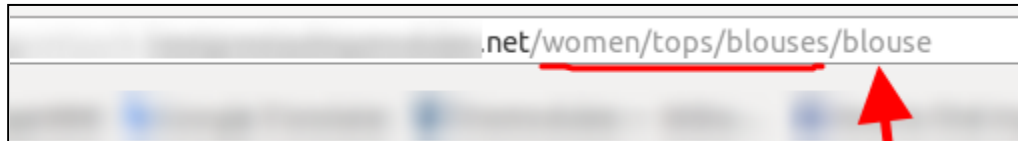
URLs of Categories/Products:

- As for the Products and Categories URLs we recommend using these default URLs settings but you can add **.html** for product URLs if you like.

Route to products	{categories:}/{rewrite}	
Keywords: id, rewrite*, ean13, category, categories, reference, meta_keywo		
Route to category	{rewrite}	
Keywords: id, rewrite*, meta_keywords, meta_title		



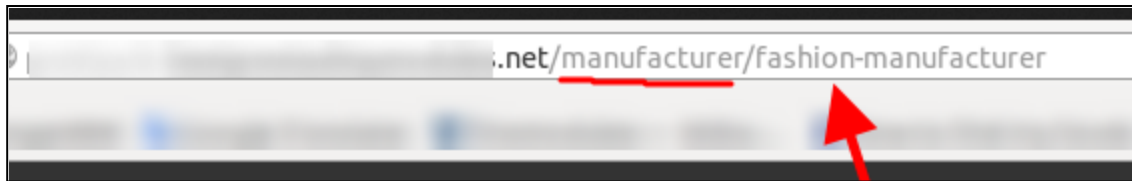
- You can also remove “{categories:/}” from product URLs to get rid of category URLs trail. As you can see in below image the URL contains category path.



- For categories URLs you can add meta_keywords, meta_title in URL but it is not recommended.

URLs of Supplier/Manufacturer:

- For supplier URL route you can rename “supplier” to any other word of your choice and the same goes for manufacturer URLs also.



URLs of CMS Pages:

- For CMS pages URL route you can rename “content/” to any word you like for example “page”, “company”.



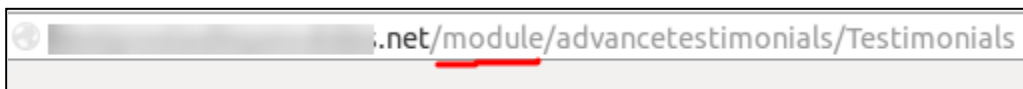
URLs of CMS Categories:

- For CMS categories URL route you can rename “content/” and “category” to any word you like for example “page”, “company”.



URLs of Module:

- For module routes we recommend to use default settings as changing it might disturb URL behavior.



Pretty URL structures are given below:

Layered Navigation	{rewrite}/filter{selected_filters}
Route to supplier	supplier/{rewrite}
Route to manufacturer	manufacturer/{rewrite}
Route to CMS page	content/{rewrite}
Route to CMS category	content/category/{rewrite}
Route to modules	module/{module}/{/:controller}

Restoring URL Structure:

If you want to disable new URL structure for other stores just simply copy below structure for that specific store.

These are default URL structure for PrestaShop.

Route to products	{category:}/{id}-{rewrite}{-ean13}.html
Route to category	{id}-{rewrite}
Layered Navigation	{id}-{rewrite}/{/:selected_filters}
Route to supplier	{id}_{rewrite}
Route to manufacturer	{id}_{rewrite}
Route to CMS page	content/{id}-{rewrite}
Route to CMS category	content/category/{id}-{rewrite}
Route to modules	module/{module}/{/:controller}
